The Biłgoraj powiat focuses on the development of young people. It is here that young people benefit from an excellent educational offer that allows them to develop their skills and passions in the local environment. More than 500 students have been supported.

Thanks to support from European Funds, students from 3 vocational schools are studying in renovated workshop rooms, using modern equipment for car diagnostics, doing precision metalworking and practical vocational training in the construction industry. Each of us should have equal access to education and development. Projects implemented thanks to European Funds are opportunities for the social and economic revitalisation of our region. The Hrubieszów Heritage Centre was created for people at risk of exclusion, who need support and understanding.

The degraded urban space was renovated mainly to address the social problems of the local community. The implementation of the project enabled the renovation of the building at 10 3 Maja Street and the development of the surrounding spaces. A place corresponding to the real needs of Hrubieszów residents was created here. With its wide range of activities, the project meets the needs of young people, seniors, families with children and people with disabilities. They now develop their educational needs and passions using the Youth Meeting Place, the Educational Space for Children and Parents, the Hrubieszów University of the Third Age and the Hrubieszów Volunteer Centre.

The EU funds have helped to remove barriers to access to education, and the residents have been given an opportunity to become actively involved in the life of the city and to influence its further development.

The knowledge and skills acquired by students in the education process are of great importance and determine their future competitiveness in the labour market. Young and well-educated employees are the lifeblood of businesses. In 6 vocational schools in the Puławy Poviát, students pass their qualification examinations with A+ grades. New solutions have been implemented for more than 200 students in, among others, Basic Vocational School No. 1 of Puławy, Basic Vocational School No. 2 of Puławy, Basic Vocational School No. 2 of Nałęczów, Basic Vocational School of Kazimierz Dolny, the Vocational Training Group of Schools and the Youth Sociotherapy Centre, enabling them to gain practical knowledge and relevant qualifications, also in deficit occupations. Thanks to projects funded by the EU Funds, young people have an opportunity to take part in additional training and apprenticeships during workshops in adequately equipped workshop rooms. Nearly 40 teachers have received support in the form of supplementary training and postgraduate studies, which contributed to raising the level of teaching.

The effect of the EU project is not only to improve the quality of education, but also to broaden opportunities for vocational school graduates and develop entrepreneurship in the area of the Puławy Poviát and our region.

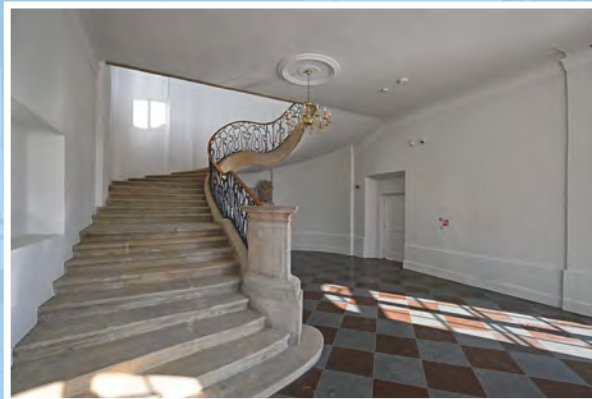


Radzyń Podlaski is a town whose pearl is the Potocki Palace. It is a place that, thanks to the European funds, has regained its former splendour. The eighteenth-century Potocki Palace underwent a comprehensive renovation, which made it possible to adapt the building for cultural and tourist activities. The interior of the main body of the palace was renovated and rebuilt, along with the internal installations, new floors and tiles in the rooms were made, the surface of the courtyard was rebuilt, the drainage of the area was carried out, the underground networks were rebuilt and the retaining wall was renewed.

The town centre was also revitalised and adapted to the needs of residents and tourists visiting Radzyń Podlaski. The surface of the Market Square was replaced, the stairs to the residential buildings were rebuilt, a beautiful fountain was erected and lighting was installed, which not only improves safety but also creates a unique atmosphere for evening strolls. The residents are enjoying the new recreation areas and are keen to use the historical and cultural potential of the town to create spaces that are friendly to every-day life and relaxing.

Thanks to the EU funds, Radzyń Podlaski has become an attractive place for residents and tourists, without ignoring the needs of people with disabilities.

Thanks to European Funds, the centre of Ryki is an attractive place for residents and visitors. The park located in the town has been renovated and made more attractive due to a new surface, benches and green planting. Modern lighting gives residents a sense of security.

The building in Poniatowskiego Street was also adapted to the needs of the local residents, and as part of the project, the ceiling and external walls were insulated, the electrical fittings and central heating systems were installed, the interior of the building was rebuilt, the window frames were replaced and a lift for people with disabilities was installed. It presently houses the Social Activity Centre, which operates within the Ryki Social Welfare Centre. It is a place where older people and people with disabilities can spend time actively, participating in different workshops, integration activities and gaining psychological support. Thanks to such activities, senior citizens and people at risk of exclusion are not marginalised and can share their knowledge and experience with younger residents.

Ryki can also boast of new road infrastructure. This has improved safety, travel comfort and quality of life for the residents.

The common and well-maintained spaces make the residents feel proud of their place of residence. And all this was achieved with the help of European Funds.

Thanks to the restoration works carried out, the development of a website and a virtual game, the discovery of history has become attractive for all ages. Today, the temple is another important place on the tourist map of the Lubelskie Voivodeship.

European Funds enabled an easier access to rail and bus transport for the region residents. The newly built Metropolitan Railway Station in Lublin, the expanded bicycle infrastructure, new public transport routes and facilities adapted for people with disabilities will significantly improve residents' daily commuting to school, work, travelling to a public institution or to see a doctor. Now public transport will be more competitive, more comfortable and, most importantly, environmentally friendly, as well as accessible to everybody. Implementation of such projects is another step towards increasing and improving the quality of life of residents and encouraging new users to use public transport. The Lubelskie Voivodeship has become a more attractive and better connected place for tourists and visitors, which will certainly trigger the development of the tourist economy and creation of new jobs.

The implementation of the project will contribute to an increase in the attractiveness of the low-carbon public transport system, promoting its alternative ecological forms. It is estimated that, thanks to this investment, the number of public transport services will be more than 3.9 million units/year, the number of cyclists using parking spaces will be more than 6 thousand, and the number of vehicles using parking spaces will be more than 30 thousand.

The project, implemented with European Funds for the thermal modernisation of the Social Welfare Facility of Kalinka, has brought numerous benefits both for its residents and for the entire Parczew Poviast. Its main objective was to increase energy efficiency in public utility buildings.

The thermal modernisation works, such as modernisation of the central heating system, roof, ceiling, external wall and foundation insulation, as well as replacement of windows and doors, were carried out in three buildings: Social Welfare Facility of Kalinka, the workshop and therapy building and the administration building. The results are impressive. Energy efficiency has increased by more than 55%.

Such investments not only save energy, but also reduce greenhouse gas emissions and thus ensure clean air for everyone. This is a significant contribution to the sustainable development of the Lubelskie voivodeship.

The implementation of the project has improved the living conditions of the residents of the Social Welfare Facility and created new opportunities for them to benefit from workshops and occupational therapy.

European funds support the youngest inhabitants of our region. Children with disabilities aged 3 to 9 who live in the Włodawa Poviát have been given a unique opportunity to receive support in the form of therapeutic and rehabilitation activities. The programme of activities, implemented thanks to European Funds, has been adapted to the individual needs of each child.

Children can participate in a variety of activities, such as physical activities, dog therapy, integration classes to develop social skills, speech therapy, sensory integration or behavioural therapy.

Also teachers and supervisors who work with children with disabilities on a daily basis have received a lot of support. Special training and courses were provided for them to adapt their competences to the needs of the children.

A new room was also converted into a kindergarten classroom, new childcare spaces were created, classrooms were equipped with appropriate equipment and teaching aids, and the outdoor playground received new safe carpeting.

Such investments are an opportunity for better development from an early age.

The City Water Reservoir in Zamość is a real treasure for the residents. They eagerly use this charming place all year round. Not only lovers of physical activity and outdoor recreation spend time here, but also those who enjoy strolling in picturesque locations. EU Funds made it possible to build a pedestrian and bicycle path, provide new benches, bike racks, as well as information and education boards and information points.

New parking spaces, alley lighting, security cameras and wireless Internet access were created, significantly increasing the convenience, accessibility, safety and attractiveness of the Water Reservoir. The observation decks are a real paradise for nature lovers. They can now observe birds and animals in their natural surroundings.

The project uses renewable energy sources, which is an important step towards sustainable use of the area, and the disability-friendly infrastructure ensures accessibility of the area to all residents and tourists.

The Lubelskie Voivodeship is becoming a place where the latest technologies are used in the fight against cancer. One of the key achievements is creation of a device - the Pro-CT mk II phantom with software dedicated to healthcare units, which helps to check that CT scanners are working properly.

This is not only a product, but also an innovative technology that allows creation of a version of the device tailored for different tasks. This makes it possible for doctors to diagnose cancer and other worrying problems in patients more accurately and quickly.

The project, implemented with European Funds, influenced the development of the production facility, where a new station was built and specialised equipment was introduced. The Pro-Project has become a leader in quality control of medical equipment used in computed tomography.

For the residents of the Lubelskie Voivodeship, this means greater confidence that they will benefit from accurate and effective medical examinations. This is a huge step towards improving healthcare and the standard of living of residents not only on a regional scale, but both nationally and internationally.

Care for older people and those with disabilities should be the priority of every community. Some actions in this regard were taken by the Kraśnik Powiat, which adapted infrastructure and tools to support people at risk of poverty and social exclusion. Having this idea in mind, a project financed by European Funds was implemented, which included the revitalization of the area of the former Outpatient Clinic at 23. Niepodległości Avenue in Kraśnik.

The renovation works, adaptation and extension of the existing building were carried out, along with comprehensive development of the surrounding area and construction works. A Community Support Centre was established here, which is a place where people can receive specialist care and support.

Adequate conditions were created to improve the quality of life of the residents by facilitating access to medical and social services and supporting people who experienced difficult life and social situations.

Taking care of a nice and coherent space in the Lublin Functional Area (LFA) is of key importance for the residents, economy, tourism and general development of the region. It is an investment in the future that brings numerous benefits to the local community. 9 municipalities cooperating under the LFA programme in the poviats of the Lubelskie Voivodeship: Lublin, Łęczna, Świdnik and Lubartów poviats have gained attractive space and new functionalities for the residents, which limit the negative effects of society aging, addiction problems and unemployment. The results of this cooperation include, for example: renovation of the historic, 19th-century Manor House in Strzyżewice, renovation of the Ewa Kołaczkowska Municipal Public Library located in the Manor House, renovation and development of degraded areas, for instance, those around the ruins of the “Kościelec” Calvinist Church (Piaski), adaptation of part of the building of the Jabłonna Municipal Office for the needs of the Municipal Public Library, or reconstruction and modernization of the existing Agronomówka building (Jastków) in order to adapt it to the needs of the Municipal Services Department, a community centre with social facilities and the Farmer Wives Association.

Thanks to these activities, the LFA has gained greater importance, it was possible to restore economic, social and cultural activities and create new job opportunities.
